CASA volunteer Guardians ad Litem (GALs) put their heart and soul into helping children who have been abused and neglected. Here are some numbers relevant to 2022:

- A collective total of **15,132 volunteer hours** were given to help kids.
- Of the active volunteers last year, 229 were female and 46 were male (the need for more male volunteers is high).
- Of the total 694 children served in 2022, 359 were female and 335 were male.
- 26 of the children served last year were less than one year of age.
 The chart to the right shows the numbers of all ages served in 2022.
- The average number of cases appointed to a volunteer GAL at a single time was 1.66; the average number of children appointed to the GAL at that same single time was 3.
- On average, one case from assignment to closure lasts 25 months.

As stated above, the numbers of children abused and neglected continue to rise – and with that comes an increased need for more volunteers. There is a specific need for a more diverse volunteer pool – one that better reflects the diversity of children served by volunteer GALs. This is especially true in terms of needing more people of color and more men to serve as trained CASA volunteers. The next volunteer training begins March 26.
